Collection of Information

Our web server automatically recognizes the domain name of your computer or web-enabled device. We collect information that you share when you complete an online registration or via other website transactions. This information may include, but is not limited to, your name, company name, company address, phone number, fax number, email address and payment information (e.g., encrypted credit card number and billing address). We may also collect information on what pages users' access or visit.

Cookie/Tracking Technology

A "cookie" is a small piece of information that a website can store in a designated file on your computer or web-enabled device. When you visit our website, we use cookies to collect aggregate information on the number of visitors to our site and the number of pages viewed. While Berk does analyze its website logs to monitor the flow of traffic and make improvements to the site's content, its website logs are not personally identifiable, and no attempt is made to link them to individual visitors to this site. This information is used only by Berk and is not shared with any third-party companies.

If you register, we place a unique identifier cookie that is used to maintain your "sign on" status for the duration of your visit to the site, customize or tailor your visit and to store your user preferences for that site over time. We also use cookies to track the pages visited so that we can deliver Berk web content based on a visitor's profile (as provided by the visitor) and the visitor's past activity on that site. The use of these cookies also enables our sites to "remember" the items that visitors add to their shopping carts.

Distribution of Information

We may share information with governmental agencies or other companies assisting us in fraud prevention or investigation.
